Notice we set the Tehama Codling Moth Biofix for 3/30/09. Those traps are in Ashley Walnuts in the Cone grove area of Tehama County. We have good consistent catches of Male moths. If you are experimenting with pheromone puffers be sure to use combo lures to monitor moth populations.
